About the Speakers

Prof. Paul MH Dummer

Prof Dummer is a Professor of Restorative Dentistry and Vice Dean at the School of Dentistry, Cardiff University, Cardiff, UK. Paul graduated from Cardiff and completed his MScD in 1980 and PhD in 1987 within the fields of dental plaque and cariology respectively. He has published over 130 original scientific articles, 50 research abstracts, and written several chapters in textbooks. Within endodontics, Paul has a particular interest in the evaluation of root canal preparation techniques and endodontic instruments. Paul has lectured extensively and he has presented over 300 hands-on courses in the field of root canal treatment.

Dr Pascal Zyman

Dr Pascal Zyman graduated from Paris VII, D.Diderot School of Dentistry in 1985. He received his certificates in both Dental materials and Prosthetic Dentistry from the same University. A past-president of the French Society of Aesthetic Dentistry, Dr Zyman maintains a clinical appointment in the Department of restorative dentistry in Paris VII as well as a private practice in Paris, limited to Aesthetic Dentistry. He is also a consultant at the American Hospital of Paris. An active member of the European Academy of Aesthetic Dentistry, and an associate member of the American Academy, Dr Zyman lectures nationally and internationally having given over 250 lectures worldwide.

Dr Martin Groten

Dr Groten is Assistant Professor and Clinical Prosthodontist in the Department of Prosthodontics of the Dental Clinic at the University of Tübingen. His clinical foci are fixed and implant prosthodontics, all-ceramic restorations, the application of adhesive techniques in prosthodontics, and the photographic documentation of clinical treatment measures. As principle clinical investigator since 1995, he has been involved in planning, designing, conducting, and evaluating clinical studies and is the author/ co-author of numerous publications, mainly on all-ceramic restoration systems and related topics and a textbook of clinical investigations in dentistry.

Prof. Dr German Gomez-Roman

Prof. Dr. Gomez-Roman graduated in 1986 from Tübingen University and has since worked in the Department of Operative Dentistry, Oral Surgery and Periodontics. Prof. Dr Gomez-Roman has spent 8 years as the Head of Implantology and Assistant Medical Director in the Department of Prosthodontics in the same University. He is also an oral surgeon, Specialist in Prosthodontics, Consultant of the German Society of Prosthodontics and a member of the Executive Board of the German Society of Implantology (DGI). Prof. Dr. Gomez-Roman is well known as a lecturer in implant therapy both nationally and internationally.

Dr M A Sartawi

Dr Sartawi is a Jordanian British Consultant Maxillofacial Surgeon with 20 years of worldwide academic and clinical experience. He is the Director of the Jordan British Specialty Center for Maxillofacial Surgery, Dentistry and Dental Implants in Amman, Jordan. He was the Chairman of the Scientific Committee of the Jordan Dental Association 2003-2004. Dr Sartawi is also an International Lecturer: lecturing widely in Jordan, the Middle East and Europe; particularly on Orthognathic Surgery, Maxillofacial access to orbital & skull base tumors, reconstructive surgery and war injuries. He is the Opinion Leader for both Xive Dental Implant and Stryker Osteosynthesis in the Middle East.
